

Cantle Grant Program

Application Guidelines

The Golden & District Community Foundation (GDCF) invites people in the arts to submit project proposals for funding consideration under the Cantle Grant Program. The grant accepts any project application related to the arts that serves Golden and Area A. Funds from this grant can be used to cover participant expenses, facilitated workshops, art(s) supplies, or large equipment.

Eligibility:

- must serve Golden and Area A
- must be related to the arts
- applicant must be aged 12 or older

Reminders:

- GDCF maintains the right to audit projects at any time.
- Successful applications will be subject to an agreement. Not meeting the terms of this agreement may jeopardize current and future funding to the applicant
- Your project must not relieve any level of government of its normal obligations or promote any form of discrimination nor cause environmental degradation

What projects are eligible?

- Visual arts such graphic arts/design and painting
- Music, such as individual instrumental skills or voice, with no limit in respect to type of instrument or genre
- Photography
- Printmaking
- Pottery and sculpture
- Theatre and film
- Dance
- Puppetry
- Writing (fiction, non-fiction and poetry), any genre
- Comedy
