Application Guidelines

The Golden & District Community Foundation (GDCF) invites youth aged 12 to 18 years of age to submit project proposals for funding consideration under the Youth and Leadership Award.

- The objective is to empower youth to lead the application process and develop skills working with partnering non-profits
- The applicant must apply under a registered NFP or charity organization
- Your project must not:
 - Relieve any level of government of its normal obligations
 - Promote any form of discrimination nor cause environmental degradation
- GDCF maintains the right to audit projects at any time.
- Successful applications will be subject to an agreement. Not meeting the terms of this agreement may jeopardize current and future funding to the applicant organization.
- All projects must be completed and final reports received by the date set in the agreement
- This award is funded by the interest earned on the following permanent endowments: Youth in Sport, Youth Opportunities, Adventure Realm Canada Fund.

What projects are eligible?

- Youth working for local community benefit
- Youth demonstrating leadership in the community
- Youth opportunities in sport or outdoor activities
